Following our defeats at the hands of Brislington and Avon Athletic, third place was ours if we could beat Bitton. They were in with a chance of the runners-up spot, along with Warmley. With Liam ill and Jason absent, we had Tom and Jay on the bench and lined up:

Dan tried a shot straight from the kick-off, but it lacked length and was easily fielded by the 'keeper. Bitton responded with a shot from the edge of the area that found the side netting.

Eight minutes gone and a free kick out on the left saw the ball played to the edge of the six-yard box. Dan's attempted headed clearance only fell to two unmarked Bitton players at the back post. One was all that was needed to curl the ball past Nick and inside the post (0-1).

Craig burst through and tried a shot from 25 yards but hit it straight at the 'keeper. Mark then played the ball down the right wing for Curtis to chase and win a corner. Ross the corner deep, just over Joe's head, but we recovered and Phil played the ball in for Curtis to shoot, but it lacked power.

Twenty minutes gone and Bitton caught us on the counter attack; an attacker got between Mark and Joe and calmly slotted the ball past Nick (0-2).

Curtis and lan combined well on the left, culminating in a low drive that the 'keeper to got down to save.

A long ball was played down the right wing for Nick Frost to chase and, showing a surprising turn of pace, got to the ball turned back and passed for Nick Guest to get in a cross that was cleared.

Within five minutes it was clear that were the stronger side with their managers getting nervous and shouting a lot on the line.

A high ball in to our box was missed by Curtis and headed behind for a goalkick. It was the only ball he missed. Another high ball was punched clear and a third was held comfortably. After that he was a virtual spectator as we ran rampant.

Ross played a neat one-two with Tom, fed Ian and the cross was just too close to the 'keeper. lan and Tom then combined well to put Nick Frost through, but the left back managed to put the ball out for a throw. Gareth threw to Nick Guest who passed to Phil, whose through ball was just too close to the 'keeper.

A throw on the right from Mark was headed in to the penalty area from Jay to Phil, to Jay for a spectacular overhead. Unfortunately it went up rather than goalward and harmlessly over the bar.

An excellent ball from Tom into the corner was chased down by Jay. He laid it back to Ross who passed inside to Ian to get to the goal line and cross. Unfortunately no one was in on goal and the ball was cleared.

With 20 minutes gone the ball was played through and Jay reacted faster than anyone else including the 'keeper to prod the ball home (2-3).
