A minute later and Joe miss-kicked, the ball was intercepted and a Whitchurch player ran between Curtis and Jason to comfortably beat Nick (0-2).

We did actually manage an attempt on goal within the first five minutes, a good ball inside from Ross allowing Danny a left foot strike that was straight at the 'keeper. However, play came straight back down our end. A short throw saw the ball crossed deep past the far post. Nick tried to get to the cross but was beaten by the header back over him and a Whitchurch forward was unmarked, two yards from goal, facing an empty net (0-3).

Curtis was booked after 20 minutes for leaving a foot in, and with the horse now having bolted several miles down the road, Andy switched to 4-4-2, with Liam moving to left back. We huffed and puffed in midfield, where only Ian came out of the game with any credit, and never looked threatening up-front or comfortable at the back.
