With Phil failing a pre-match fitness test and Greg refereeing the game, we lined up:

Some settled early play saw us create the first few chances. Jon received the ball from Gareth's throw and turned to fire in a shot across the face of the goal. A minute later and a run down the right wing by Gareth ended with a cross that the 'keeper held just under the bar.

Joe then made a good interception and made ground down the right flank before whipping in an excellent cross to the unmarked Jon, eight yards out. Whether or not he was mesmerised by the quality of the delivery I don't know, but unfortunately the ball stuck under his feet and a defender managed to get in a telling tackle.

A long-range effort from Danny Burton that was straight in to Ryan's hands was the only response from Whitchurch.

We took the lead after eight minutes. Jon got in another cross from the right that nearly picked out Jamie, a retreating defender forced to head the ball over his own bar. Jack's corner kick was headed downwards towards the goal by Tom, but cleared to the edge of the area. Rich had a shot that was blocked and Jack's effort to turn the ball back in to the six-yard box was also blocked. Rich picked up the loose ball and crossed for **Jon** to beat the appeals for offside and the 'keeper with a shot high in to the net (1-0).

A good passing move saw Jon pick out Gareth, who put in a good cross that Zolly couldn't quite get on the end of. However, with just over a quarter of an hour gone the delivery was spot on. A head-on by Rich from Tom's throw saw Jon work an opening on the right touchline with some nifty footwork and get in a cross that saw the ball beat the despairing lunge of a defender and land at the feet of **Zolly**. No mistake with the finish (2-0).

Mid way through the first half and Whitchurch were having problems with our long through balls and penetrating runs. Their more leisurely passing game seemingly playing in to our hands as Tom and Dan were in total control in the centre of defence and neither Mark nor Joe were overly worked. They did come close to scoring with ten minutes of the half remaining. A cross in from our left flank evaded everyone and was collected on our right flank by a Whitchurch player who cut in to strike a good shot that Ryan flew across his goal to fist round the post.

A shot from Zolly from 20 yards, five minutes before half time, that hit the side-netting was the nearest we came to extending our lead.

HALF TIME : COLTS 2 WHITCHURCH 0

We kicked off the second half and two minutes in to the half Whitchurch were reduced to ten players – the dismissal coming for foul and abusive language directed at Greg.

Ten minutes in to the half and we were nearly caught out as Whitchurch successfully defended a corner and broke quickly. Ryan hared out of his area and closed down Craig Mehew sufficiently for him to hurry his lob which missed the empty net by only a couple of yards.

With a quarter of an hour gone Gareth came off to be replaced by Jay who took up position on the left, Zolly switching to the right.

Tom hobbled off with a leg injury with just over 20 minutes remaining, which shouldn't have posed any problems, but did! Various discussions appeared to take place as to whether we should play with a back three, or should Joe slot in to the middle or someone else?

Rich dropped in to the back four and Ross came on up front. Jay moved inside and Jon dropped back in to the wide left midfield berth. Several times we went close to adding to our tally. A good through ball from Mark saw Jamie loose out to the 'keeper in a race for the ball. Jack had a strike that was wide, and Jon got in a couple of shots on target that lacked power.

However, whether the positional changes proved confusing or whether we turned off mentally I don't know. Whitchurch started to threaten a bit more. With just over a quarter of an hour remaining Danny Burton turned and hit a good left foot shot that crashed back off the bar. Just over five minutes remaining and Mark misjudged a header that left Dan stranded. Rich was nowhere to be seen and Joe was marking space. The net result was a Whitchurch player running through and finishing low past Ryan (2-1).

Jack now dropped in to the back four alongside Dan, as we moved towards the end of the game.

In to stoppage time and we were still pressing forward. A cross in from Jamie was headed over by Ross, and then a good ball from Ross out to Jon on the left saw him cross for Jamie to bring out a good save from the 'keeper. The ball was played straight back down to our end where Mark allowed Craig Mehew too much space and his shot from the left hand edge of the area beat the advancing Ryan (2-2).

Afterthoughts.....

We controlled most of the game, and created most of the chances. We were lucky to come out with a 1-0 win against Whitchurch last time out. This time we gifted them a point by not taking our chances and by sloppy defending at the end after we had played some good football for most of the game. Disappointing.
