FRY CLUB COLTS: U16MATCHREPORT

With Liam unavailable, but three substitutes available, Ben went off for a game with the U18s. Unfortunately, Jason and Jay never turned up, so we only had the one substitute after all, and lined up:

Henbury kicked off, but it was us who managed the first effort on goal, Rick testing the 'keeper with a drive from the edge of the penalty area that was safely held. Henbury responded after five minutes with a firmly hit shot from 25 yards that was straight at Nick.

Ten minutes gone and Dan received the ball on the left and played it inside to lan who laid it off to **Curtis**. A touch inside and the ball was positioned for a powerful low right-foot shot that the 'keeper seemed to react to late, and allow to squirm inside the post (1-0).

It was nearly ten minutes later before we created another chance, Dan getting a head to Rick's cross and the ball finding Danny who hooked the ball against the 'keeper. The loose ball fell to Curtis who dragged his shot wide, with the 'keeper still grounded.

With half an hour gone Phil couldn't cut out a cross from the left flank, the touch he did get just deflecting it enough to prevent Tom from getting sufficient purchase on the ball to clear and the ball sat up nicely for a Henbury player to stab home (1-1). A minute later and Henbury forced a corner on the right. Nick managed to block a hooked shot at the near post, but Mark – facing his own goal – could only get a toe to the ball and in trying to clear over the bar knocked the ball in to his own net (1-2).

This sudden turn around in fortunes, as we had played some good football in the first half, spurred Henbury on, and they finished the half strongly with a good last ten minutes seeing us under a little pressure — particularly lan who felt the pressure of a boot in the face on the stroke of half-time!

HALF-TIME: HENBURY 2 FRY CLUB 1

Danny won a corner on the left that Curtis took, but Tom was penalised for pushing. A minute later and a lobbed through ball from Mark saw Danny rushing in and the 'keeper rushing out. Danny won the chase, lifted the ball over the 'keeper, ran round him, and with the empty goal in front of him hit the ball wide.

Ten minutes in to the half and we switched to a back three with Joe pushing forward, and Ricky coming on to play just behind the front two, Ian coming off. The next quarter of an hour saw us pushing forward more, but not being particularly effective in the final third of the pitch. A shot from Dan, straight at the 'keeper; a weak finish from Danny; a lob from distance by Rick that cleared the bar, and a corner that Henbury cleared with ease were all our efforts amounted to.

With just over ten minutes remaining, a good ball down the left from Rick saw Dan slip a tackle and make ground along the goal line. Joe was unable to control the low cross to the near post, but the ball rebounded to Dan who struck the ball firmly home from a tight angle (2-2).

We picked up the pace and went looking for the winner. Two minutes later and Joe did well to dig the ball back from the goal-line on the right of the penalty area but both Dan and Danny went for the ball and got in each other's way, allowing the 'keeper to collect it. Then a good flick-on from Danny found Dan galloping through only to be foiled as the 'keeper managed to get a good block on the attempted lob. Curtis then picked up the ball in midfield and drove a shot just wide.

In to the last five minutes of the half and Rick had the keeper scrambling to a shot on the turn that was just

wide of the post. Joe then found Dan who flicked the ball on for Danny but his touch took the ball too far in front of him and the 'keeper claimed the ball. The ball was quickly cleared and Curtis was unfortunate that his prodded pass found a Henbury player rather than the intended Phil, who cracked the ball home (2-3).
