As I'd gone away for a long week-end break I thought that I'd got out of this week's report; so a big thank-you to Dave Kavanagh who single-handedly took notes, and in legible writing!

Fry's kicked off, playing in to the sun and the wind, and after some early scrappy play we produced the first shot of the game – from Curtis, but well wide. A corner from the right picked out Joe's head perfectly, but the header was wide of the post. This was followed by a good run from Curtis to the left by-line that ended with a cross for Mike to shoot.

A fine through ball from Joe found Ricky, and his return ball enabled Joe to get in a shot that was again off-target, before a well-worked move across the field ended with the 'keeper holding on to a shot from Ian. However, with a quarter of an hour gone, poor defending allowed Yatton their first shot of the game, from which they scored (0-1).

From another good forward move Joe hit a left-foot shot, but again it was wide. The equaliser was not long in coming though; 20 minutes gone and **Rick** was free on the right to shoot across the 'keeper and in to the far corner of the net (1-1). Andy now shuffled the players around and moved Liam to left back, Joe to central midfield, and Jason to left wing. Almost immediately, a good run from Jason ended with him being fouled, and from the free kick Danny's header was saved by the 'keeper.

A scramble on the left resulted in a shot from Danny across the face of the goal, but nobody was there to apply the necessary touch to convert the chance.

With half time only five minutes away, a super run from Danny ended with another cross right on to Joe's head, only for him to miss when it seemed easier to score! A good ball out of defence from Liam to Danny brought another cross that we were unable to convert before a great ball from Curtis found Rick who managed to lob the 'keeper for **Jason** to score from a narrow angle (2-1).

HALF-TIME: YATTON 1 FRY CLUB 2

Two minutes in to the half and a great shot from Curtis brought out a good save from the Yatton 'keeper, diving to his left. A good run from Ricky then ended with another shot that went across the face of the goal. Rick was then fouled, out on the right, and took the free kick himself, only for Danny's header to be slightly too high of the goal.

Ten minutes in to the half and Andy moved Curtis in to midfield and moved Joe back to sweeper. Within five minutes the change produced a goal; a Yatton through ball saw confusion between Joe and Nick, and the ball ran free for Yatton to equalise (2-2).

Straight from the kick-off a good shot from Danny just cleared the crossbar, and then, with 20 minutes remaining, we re-gained the lead. The Yatton 'keeper made a save from a corner, but the ball fell for **Jason** to fire home (3-2). A run down the left saw Ricky cut inside and drive just wide of the far post before a Yatton clearance fell for **Curtis**, who shrugged off several tackles before firing the ball home from 30 yards (4-2). Shortly afterwards and a corner on the right saw the ball drop for **Curtis** to hammer the ball home (5-2), and then a run from Rick finished with a pass to Curtis who was off-target on this occasion.

With ten minutes remaining, a good ball from Tom found Jason who forced a corner which again dropped for **Curtis** to clinch his hat-trick (6-2).

From another corner, on the left, **Rick** shot home from the edge of the area (7-2) before a run from Danny ended with him being brought down but our penalty appeals denied. Finally, a good ball from Curtis saw **Jason** round off the scoring (8-2), and provide him with a hat-trick, too.
