Thank goodness we only play once at Lansdowne – it's windier even than Fry's! Kicking into the wind, we took a third minute lead when Danny and Rick combined for **Dan** to fire home from the edge of the six-yard box (1-0).

We strengthened our hold on the game with a second goal after a quarter of an hour. A good run down the left flank from Danny saw him lay the ball back for Ian who lifted the ball over Bamfield's centre-half for **Danny** to collect and lob the advancing 'keeper (2-0).

A corner on the right from Rick saw the wind carry the ball almost to the edge of the penalty area where Tom's acrobatic overhead kick connected well, only for the ball to dip just over the bar.

Phil, Liam and Ian then combined well in a move down the left that ended with Danny coming in smartly at the near post and flicking the ball just over the bar.

Although Bamfield had the benefit of the wind behind them they were not imposing any real threat – a couple of efforts in to the tree behind Nick's goal were about all they could muster as our defence held better shape than it had against Bitton last week.

With half an hour gone a fine through ball from Mark found Danny who advanced on the 'keeper and

chipped the ball neatly over his head only for the ball to just clear the bar when it seemed to have been hit perfectly - the wind must have suddenly dropped Pete!

In to the last five minutes of the half and a brilliant interception by Joe and 20 yard run ended with a measured through ball that **Dan** met cleanly to plant past the 'keeper (3-0).

Five minutes in to the half and Curtis entertained us with a bit of showboating just outside the opposition area before crossing the ball. Tom's shot from the edge of the area was well struck and heading just inside the post only for the Bamfield 'keeper to fling himself across his goal and palm the ball away for a corner.

Two minutes later, and Mark and Dan combined to set up Danny. He hit a good shot on the turn that was arrowing in to the top corner of the net only for the 'keeper to again make a flying save. Dan went up with the 'keeper to meet Rick's corner kick. The 'keeper fumbled the ball and it dropped for **Mark** to prod it home from all of six inches (4-0). Tom and Dan made way for Mike and Ricky, and we adopted a five-man midfield as Curtis pushed forward.

With a quarter of an hour gone a long clearance from Bamfield was met with a clever backward header by Joe that allowed Nick to rush out and boot the ball upfield for Danny to run on to and beat the 'keeper with his cross. **Ricky** had timed his run nicely to meet the cross and tucked the ball home (5-0).

Five minutes later and a corner on the right from Rick saw **Mark** rise at the near post and head firmly home (6-0). Another minute and another goal. Neat footwork from **Rick** and what looked deceptively like a cross to the far post dipped under the bar – clearly an excellent shot (7-0)!

In to the final quarter of an hour and Danny had an attempt ruled out for offside before Curtis let rip with about his fourth effort from 30 yards, but his first on target, that brought a fine save at the foot of the post.

From the resulting corner, Rick played the ball short to Curtis, and his hanging cross was again dropped by the 'keeper and although a defender managed to stop the ball crossing the line, again **Mark** was on hand to ram the ball home (8-0). With ten minutes remaining Ricky and Ian combined well to set up **Mark** who slid in to beat the 'keeper for a fourth time (9-0).
