We got off to a cracking start. A couple of half chances at either end had come to nothing. However, with just under five minutes gone, Mike latched on to a ball half-cleared from a corner, crossed from the right and **Danny** managed to climb just high enough to loop a header under the bar. The 'keeper managed to get a hand to the ball and for a second it looked like he was going to claw it clear; fortunately not (1-0).

A quarter of an hour gone, and consternation in our penalty area. The ball was pinging about and both Tom and Phil managed to get in vital interceptions before Nick managed to grab hold of the ball. Five minutes later though and Brislington equalised. A shot from the left edge of the area beat Nick only to rebound from the crossbar and land at the feet of a Brislington attacker, ten yards from goal on the right of the area. His firmly hit shot gave Nick no chance (1-1).

With a quarter of an hour of the half remaining, Mike was booked for a two footed tackle, and play continued to be dominated by the defences. Dan and Danny weren't getting much support up front, but we weren't over-run at the back, and it wasn't until the final minutes before half time that our rearguard was almost breached when, again, a goalmouth melee saw bodies being thrown in front of the ball to prevent a shot coming in, and Rick eventually managing to clear.

We did nearly manage a second goal when Mike sent in a free kick from the right after Rick had been fouled, Danny's downward header bouncing just the wrong side of the post. However, the first half belonged to Brislington, they were first to the ball in almost every instance, had attacked in numbers and had policed our front players admirably — Dan often marked by three players and yet still Brislington appeared to have players free!

HALF-TIME: FRY CLUB 1 BRISLINGTON 1

For the second half Mike moved in to the back four and Joe moved in to midfield. Ten minutes in to the half and we gained a corner on the right. Rick's cross was met with a header from Danny that the 'keeper plucked from the air and cleared long. Although lan managed to get in a tackle it was at the expense of a penalty, struck home firmly (1-2).

We weren't at our most fluent and, as a unit, our midfield was not at its best. Brislington were moving about and we looked static. Too many passes were going astray. A quickly taken free kick from Dan to a lively run from Ricky was a rare occasion when we got clear of Brislington's shackles.

Twenty minutes gone and chances at both ends had been almost non-existent. A Brislington header over the bar from 10 yards being one of the few.

With a quarter of an hour remaining, in a game we needed to win to have any realistic title aspirations, Andy pushed Curtis into midfield and Joe dropped in to defence. A minute later and Dan was about to take a throw-in when Andy yelled for him to leave the ball and get in the middle. Mike's throw was headed on to lan at the far post, who drilled in a low shot that Dan latched on to and he slammed the ball home (2-2).

With less than ten minutes remaining, a ball forward saw a Brislington player burst between two defenders and lift the ball over the advancing Nick (2-3). Five minutes later and Phil slipped, allowing Brislington to get in a cross from the left flank. Poor defending at the far post saw a Brislington player have the time to control the ball and curl it over Nick and in to the corner of the net (2-4).

A mazy dribble from Curtis saw him brought down, but Tom's free kick was easily saved by the 'keeper, as Brislington held out for the final couple of minutes.
