They launched straight into an attack with the player through on goal. Jamie stayed on his line allowing the attacker to shoot, but he completely missed the ball and Jamie calmly picked the ball up. Max got the ball and passed forward to Zac but he was tackled as he bore in on the goal. They attacked back at us, three players against Jack, but he was able to clear for a corner. Jordan passed forward to Zac, but he was tackled, it came to Max and he passed forward well to Zac but again he was tackled by the last man. Josef won the ball and passed it forward to Zac who shot but a Warmley player got in the way. Sam passed a long ball forward to Dan who knocked it on to Zac but he was challenged and won a corner.
