First up were the Yellow Team - The line up was:

Straight from the kick, we are on the attack and Zac almost capitalised on some indecision in the Keynsham defence, but just as he was about to shoot, the last defender got his boot to it and out of danger. They attacked down the middle but Jamie was quick to defend and Aaron scooped up the ball. A free kick against Dan for handball was well struck but Jamie was there with the clearance again. Tom was then fouled on the edge of the area. His free kick was forwards to Mark on the halfway line. Mark passed to Josef who passed it on to Zac. Zac went wide left and shot but the ball was cleared out as far as Tom. Tom went right, then left and hit it back to **Zac**. He hit a first time shot and the ball nestled in the back of the net **0-1**.

Tom then defended on the edge of our area. He broke forwards past three players and hit a great ball towards Dan. Dan passed it past their last defender towards **Mark** who went wide and then shot high **0-2**. Tom broke out of defence again, passed a great ball to Zac who shot from twenty yards but the 'keeper made the save. Keynsham then broke through our defence and Aaron had to be quick off of his line to clear. Unfortunately the ref had already blown for a free kick just outside our area. They hit it hard but Dan blocked. He then ran forwards, blocked again and cleared the ball. Keynsham had moments of danger however and a ball into the area found an unmarked player. His shot however was high and wide.

A Keynsham player then broke through and Tom ended up giving away a free kick to stop him. They took the free kick, which Tom cleared and both Mark and Zac made sure,

hitting it into the far right corner where Dan chased. He passed to Josef who crossed it in to Mark who shot. They cleared the ball to **Zac** who beat a player and then hit the ball high and hard **0-3**. Joe then took a turn to attack down the left, crossed it in brilliantly to Dan but his shot was just wide. The ball came out to Max who beat two players and bore down on goal only for the second defender to get back and make the stop.

Aaron kicked out and they attacked, only to find Sam resolute in defence. His high clearance was brought down by Max, who cut in from the right, past two players, but his shot was saved. Sam was in space in the middle but he chose to ignore him and hit an unstoppable shot with his left foot **1-4**. Keynsham attacked and Mark stopped them with a good ball to Sam. He tried to beat a player but was tackled and the ball came loose to **Tom**. He ran down the middle where the Keynsham defenders had gone walkabout and calmly passed the ball into the back of the net with the 'keeper stranded on his line **1-5**. At this point you could be forgiven for thinking that this was going to be a rout.

Keynsham attacked and Aaron had to be quick off of his line to get it, beat two players, and clear it for a throw. The ball comes into our area and no one really gets a good clearance before the ball is put into the back of the net **2-5**. They attacked with renewed vigour and again we were in defence without really clearing it. The ball was hit through the crowd leaving Aaron unsighted **3-5**. Joe tried to run out of defence with the ball, lost it and they shot. It hit Tom's leg but this only served to deflect it past Aaron's despairing dive **4-5**. There was time for one final attack. Zac got the ball on the edge of the area and hit it as hard as he could. The 'keeper made the save with his legs but in reality knew nothing about it until the ball hit him. It was cleared to safety.

Ethan broke wide down the right and crossed well to Luke, but his shot was saved. Keynsham then broke down our left and despite Jordan's best efforts could not be stopped as Jamie stood on his line 1-0. They then attacked down their left wing with James the last player. His strong challenge put the ball out for a corner. Jordan won the ball and passed inwards to Luke who went on a big run, which was followed by a shot. That was cleared for a corner. Keynsham attacked down the middle and Oscar made a strong challenge. The ball ran on however and James also made a strong challenge. Still the ball came on and the shot was hit past Jamie towards the net. Somehow however, Ethan had gotten back magnificently and was on the line to clear the ball. A Keynsham player handballed it on the halfway line but play continued. Jack ran through strongly shrugging off all comers but the 'keeper made a great save at his feet as he was just about to shoot. Jack attacked down the left and crossed it. It came to James and a defender. They both challenged for the ball and it went up into the air over their heads and it was cleared.

He attacked forward and then cut inside where the ball came to Ethan. Keynsham then attacked back at us down our left, past all of the defenders and hit a cross-goal shot. Jamie dived to try to save it but it was already past him. Charlie then brought the ball out of defence and hit it forwards to Sam.
