The wind was very strong for the game making good football difficult, however our boys tried anyway. In the first half, Chickwell had the wind behind them. We broke strongly out defence with both George and James making strong tackles but left Oscar on his own to defend the counter attack and their forward gave Josef no chance **1-0**. There was a bit of a melee in the defence with lots of players trying to clear the ball but the last touch was from a Chick' **2-0**. The Chicks then broke down the right wing but Oscar got there and cleared the danger. The ball was then played into our left back area and none of our team went to clear it. The cross was buried in the back of the net **3-0**. A good through ball was missed by our defenders and their good attacker went around Josef **4-0**.

We started to play a bit at this point. George made a strong tackle on the halfway line, attacked forward but his shot was saved. They attacked into our area and although Josef came for it, they scored **5-0**. Chickwell

## OVERALL RESULT: CHICKERELL 9 FRYS 10

We attacked straight from the kick off. Tom played a long ball forwards, which Joe chased. Their clearance was poor and **Joe** won it and buried it **0-1**. A poor kick by their 'keeper was won by Max and as he closed in on goal, their 'keeper recovered. Charlie then won the ball wide on the right, crossed it in but just too far ahead of Joe. Joe then attacked down the left and hit a strong shot. The 'keeper could only parry it to a lurking **Tom** who finished the job **0-2**. Joe won the ball and hit a hard shot only to see it come back off of the post and be cleared. Chickwell had a rare break but Aaron was more than ready to clear it.
