This time Joby was equal to it and made the save. Good play by both Josh & Dan signalled our arrival at the game. Tom tackled and won the ball. He followed up with a run upfield but Keynsham got the ball back. They attacked again but good defending by Jack was followed by a calm pass back to Joby.

From the melee, Jack got the ball clear and although it came back in, Jack again cleared. Keynsham then had a dangerous attack but our defence pushed them wide and clear.
