The Heathens then attacked down the left but were stopped by a great tackle by Sam B. He was however injured in the challenge and had to be carried off. Frys broke and Sam K had a top shot saved by their 'keeper for corner. From the corner however Coalpit Heath then attacked and we were left outnumbered at the back giving Jamie no chance **1-0**. They attacked again and Jamie made another great save, but in the process he got injured and so also had to come off.

By this time Sam B had been patched up and so he went in goal whilst Jamie received treatment. Next up and Dan made a great tackle to stop a Heathen attack. Sam K was brought down and got up to take the free kick. Unfortunately it was just wide. Jack then broke down the left side but the Heathens were able to stop him. A fast attack down the left-hand side earned Frys a corner. As with the first goal however, they broke quickly, and although Sam K raced back to put

pressure on the attacker, he was unable to stop them scoring another **2-0**.
