From a corner to 'Stoke, Max won the ball, ran the whole length of the pitch despite three or four attempts at a tackle, and just saw the ball cleared as he neared the goal. They attacked and Jamie looked exposed, but he managed to get to it and saved well after a long period of inactivity. James won the ball and played it towards Max who one-two'd with Jim.
