Joe swung it in from the right high, and with the wind it flew into the net 2-1. Joe threw at their box and it came out to Tom, who volleyed it first time high, and just like Joe's earlier effort, from 30 yards we all watched it drop perfectly 3-1. Joe threw a ball to the left where Spike won it. He lifted it towards the box and Dan flicked it on for Sam to head on and Chilly was in with a shot, but it was just too high. They attacked to Aaron played it back to Joel. He went for the big clearance, but mis-hit it, however luckily it cleared their attackers and Aaron kicked if for a throw.
