After winning the ball in defence, Joe played a nice ball to Chilly who controlled it and held of his man before playing a nice ball to Tom. He hit it wide to Jay who worked hard down the right, before laying it back to Dan who crossed a great ball in to Chilly who knocked it down for Joe who hit it first time with his right, but unfortunately wide. However it was defence to attack, starting and ending with the same player and involving six players! Jay worked hard down the line again to win a throw which was flicked on to Sam who cut inside and hit it low from a narrow angle and the 'keeper got down well to catch it, but then he let go and grabbed it as it almost crossed the line. They hit a ball over the top and Spike, playing in an unaccustomed role hung back ten yards and played them onside. Joel got his hands to the shot, but was unable to

keep it out 1-0. Josh played a lovely ball out of defence to Max who ran down the line and passed inside to Chilly who held off two players before finding **Tom**, and he took it on the run, past two defenders and coolly slotted it past the 'keeper 1-1.
