They had a corner which flew high in. It seemed too high for Joby and was heading for a Brislington header a yard from goal, however Joby just got his fingertips to it and took it away and Josh finished the clearance. A ball through saw Andy away, however a sliding challenge saw a foot nick it away for a throw. Another corner saw Joel rise brilliantly to head clear under pressure, Max took it on, found Tom who went wide, but the shot was into the 'keeper's arms. We took a goal-kick which they won with a header, but Joby was out quick to grab. He took a quick drop-kick to the left for Max to win and he was away down the left. He found Sam, and he had the pace to beat the right back, in towards goal, riding a challenge and from an acute angle lifted it with pace over the 'keeper 1-0. They had a long high shot, but Joby caught it. Wide again to Tom who knocked it on for Max to battle with their right-back. He laid it through for Tom who had continued his run, but it took a nasty bobble as he went to kick it, and it skewed wide. They hit a high corner over and Sam attacked it brilliantly to clear as far as the edge, however it was hit back in. they had three players on the sixyard line offside, but a fourth slightly wider and onside, and it came to him and he smashed it in 1-1. At least we can say we have an honest and fair linesman. Read on to see if they can say the same! Tom swung an attack over, but Andy & Jay were just beaten to it by their defenders. A ball down the left was won by Andy and he cut inside past their defenders and smashed it high from an acute angle, just like Sam's goal, but this one hit the bar and bounced out.
