Everyone was available, but for the first time we were on pitch 2, the hill. There was a lot of trepidation on the side-lines about this, but I wasn't too concerned.

The line up was:

Joby

Reece Brandon Aaron Joel

Bryn Sam Sammie Max

Tom Callum

Substitutes: Josh & Charlie

They won the ball on the edge of their area, and attacked down our left. They played it into the front player who flicked it wide to their right winger. He managed to get through Brandon's tackle and as Joe came across, flicked it to the far post for their attacker to tap in 0-1. From the kick off we passed it around and Max forced a throw. Callum found Sam with it and he laid it through for Max on the six yard line which Max poked wide. They then showed great pace with an attack down our right, and the cutback was behind our returning defenders for an attacker to pass in 0-2 after just five minutes. Callum came deep to get the ball and went wide for Sammie and Tom to combine well and win a throw. Sammie took it to Tom and received it back, before finding Callum on the right, and he shot for the far post, but it was gathered by the 'keeper. They went for a diagonal crossfield pass, which Joel missed, but in doing so distracted their attacker, so Sammie had it and looked long for Tom, which he also missed, and again distracted his marker, and the ball fell through for Callum who shot from the edge of the area, however it seemed to hit his shin and lost enough power that the 'keeper was able to dive full stretch and push it away for a corner. A shot from distance was parried away by Joby to a wide area, however they reacted quicker and returned it to the back post for another pass in 0-3. A simple ball over the top saw our defence stand, perhaps looking for the flag, which never came, and they just lifted the ball over the advancing Joby 0-4. Andy switched Max and Sam to give a bit more defensive pace to the left, and it helped the structure of the team a bit with Sam & Bryn now cutting out their wingers, and Sammie linking quickly with Max. Josh hit a high ball forward and Callum challenged the 'keeper wide in their area, used his body to win it, and then spun and curled for the far left post, but it rolled agonisingly wide. A centred ball was taken by Callum onto his right, beating the

defender in the movement, and shot, but it flew over. We had now lost Aaron to exhaustion, having trained for kick boxing earlier in the day..... We won a free-kick 30 yards out, and **Brandon** was instantly there, having been told on many occasions at Jamie Shore (Warmley Managers) that there were better free kick takers. He blasted one, with the 'keeper not really expecting it, and it flew in over his head **1-4**.

Brandon chested it, but the ref gave a free kick. It curved as it flew at Joby, and he wasn't able to get a firm grip, the ball ending in the net 1-5. We won the ball on the left and hit the ball towards the middle to where Callum was running in and he just lifted it with his right foot over the 'keeper 2-5. Sammie worked hard on the right, beating his man and found Bryn on the right. Bryn played it back to Sammie who switched it towards the middle and Josh challenged, distracting the defender and it found Callum, and he ran around the 'keeper and passed it into the open net 3-5. From kick off, they passed right and Callum sprinted in, past two challenges and shot with his right, but this time the 'keeper made the save. A high ball into the middle of the field saw Sammie jump and challenge, and as it came down he hit a first time ball through, with Callum having pace on the defender and he drilled it into the bottom right 4-5 and completing his second half hat-trick. They won a free kick wide on their right and floated it for the far post. They headed it goalwards, and Josh stuck out his leg to try to stop it, but only managed to help it on its way 4-6.
