Sam played a lovely ball over for Callum to split the defence, but he under-hit his attempted lob, and their 'keeper George was able to grab it. Brandon won a poor goal-kick on the halfway line, skipped past three players and found Callum, but again George was there and made the save. They broke quickly down the line and hit in a first time cross, and then rose highest to head it into the far corner 0-1. A high ball saw a bounce that Aaron just missed, and as a result Brandon was on the wrong side, however chased back well and managed to clear it wide. It was played back into the middle from the throw, and with at least eight of our players in and around the area, he managed to create space to shoot low for the far left corner and it was in 0-2. Sammie then won it from kick off and flicked it through for Callum on his right, but his shot was wide. They attacked and Aaron won it on the halfway line, before playing it in to Tom. Tom held it well and then played it to his left to where Aaron had kept running, and he then found a gap for Callum to take it on his right, however he was tackled at the same time and it went off for a corner, and at this point we had created at least double the chances they had, but were two down! Sam and Tom worked hard to find Bryn with it, and he lifted it marginally over the defender's head for Callum, but this time the shot came off of his shin, and lacked the power to beat George. They headed for goal from a corner and Aaron cleared for another. This time Reece on the line, headed it down, up and off of the crossbar, before it was cleared from the line. From a goal-kick, Sammie brought it down, jinked past two players and shot low, but George dived well and pushed it around the post. The ball was swung in from a corner and Callum touched it down to Tom, but was fouled at the time. Tom spun and shot as the ref blew for a penalty, and it nestled in the bottom right of the net 1-2. By the laws of the game, the ball should have been brought back for a penalty, however the referee elected to let the goal stand.
