From kick off, Keynsham decided to try our usual trick of conceding early. They passed it backwards and then out to our right, where Josh intercepted, passed down the line for Lorenzo, who held off Joby, before crossing in to the middle to where Callum was waiting three yards out with an open goal 0-1, 10 seconds in and even quicker than their goal at ours last season! They broke out from our corner down our right side, however Joel decided he was going for it! They crossed to our open left area where both Bryn and Reece converged, and Reece's touch on an attempted cross saw the spin take it away from them and avert the danger. We chipped a ball over to the right where Lorenzo chased. The 'keeper came out and clipped Lorenzo's ankle, however he stayed on his feet and shot from the angle, but it hit the side netting.

Keynsham took a long shot which Dec held, and then his drop kick was knocked on by Lorenzo, who ran after it and crossed in for Callum in an almost carbon copy position to put us two up **0-2**.
