Noah played a great ball over the top for Callum to race onto. He chipped the 'keeper but unfortunately it went over the top of the crossbar. St Nicks were also in on goal, but the shot was matched by a great save from Dec. After our normal slow start. St Nicks attacked down the left, crossed it in and powered the ball past Dec 1-0. Another attack down the left saw the attacker cut inside and shoot low, but Dec was equal to it down in the bottom right. Half an hour in, St Nicks moved forward passing it well, however we had three or four chances to clear the ball, but didn't take it, and suddenly the ball was threaded behind our defence and they gave Dec no chance 2-0. We then set Callum away with a ball over the top, but his shot went just wide of the post. With a few minutes to half-time St Nicks attacked in numbers and the guick movement of the ball saw them create a chance to shoot low, which they took 3-0.

Sam played the ball in from the right and Callum controlled it before firing his volley just over, however we were coming more into the game. Max won the ball in the middle and played Callum down the left. His ball across goal was just right, however Lore was just a yard away from getting there. Callum swung a corner over from the left and first the header by Sam and the shot from Aaron was blocked and cleared. Callum threw into the box which saw a scramble for the ball, and ended with Aaron's shot which was blocked. This throw fell to Bryn, however his shot was just wide. They then finally eased their pressure and won a corner. It came in, and in the words of Jon, "scramble, scramble, scramble", which ended with their fourth goal 4-1. With six or seven minutes to go we did the same back, and from the scramble, Lore squeezed it in 4-2. Max and Lore played well down the left and chipped it towards the middle, and Elliot headed it down to the right for Tom to slot into the top left 4-3 with just five minutes left.
