We won it again from their kick and forced a corner on the left. They managed to clear the corner and were away down the left with lightning pace, and the centred ball found an Avon attacker to pass it in from three yards, **1-1** after two minutes! Things calmed down then until Aaron threw to Callum who controlled it and played it over the top for **Lore** to run onto, and he ran past the 'keeper and passed it in from the right **2-1** after five minutes!
