We closed them down right from the start, not giving them any space to pass, and from our first attack forced a corner out on the right. Callum swung it in with the wind, and their player got his head to it but could only divert it into the net 1-0. They attacked and we cleared wide, but they got it back and ran at us, but Aaron stepped in to win it and send it through for Lore, and he saw Callum's run down the left and tried to find him, but the last defender dived forward and managed to head it out for a corner. Callum swung it in again and this time a defender was on the line to head it clear. Lore found space and clipped it central for Callum to race after, but their 'keeper got there about a yard ahead of him. Sam and Aaron worked in the middle to win the ball back and Sam clipped it forward. Callum controlled it well under pressure and chipped it forward for Lore to take around the 'keeper and roll it in with his left foot 2-0. Warmley finally managed to get time on the ball and worked it well down the right, before finding players in the middle, each time with their back to goal as we wouldn't let them turn, but they moved it quickly and finally created that space in front of goal from 10 yards. Dec got his body to it, but it had enough power to find the net 2-1. Warmley again kept possession well and forced their way into the game with some slick passing, this time to the left as we tried to keep up. A Warmley player received the ball in front of goal and looked to shoot as we jumped in, but instead laid it off and this time the attacker had a bit more time and space and he poked it into the corner 2-2. As half-time approached, you could see our players start to tire, as they had worked so hard to restrict Warmley's space, however a great ball down the left for Callum and he switched it to the right to where Josh had gotten forward, but his shot went just to the right of the post. They had a corner which was swung over and headed goalwards. Dec dived across, but Josh was in front of him and headed it upwards, luckily Dec still got a partial touch, and it was enough to loop it onto the top of the net.

Another nice bit of play saw the ball centred as we were trying to get to wherever the ball was, and it dropped ten yards out for a player to shoot with just Dec to beat, but Aaron launched his body across the area and managed to get the block in just in time. From a corner the ball went out 20 yards for an attacker to send in a rocket, but Dec flew across to make another fantastic save. The corner came in and our player missed it at the front post, and it rolled through everyone to the back, and was hit back across, and Dec somehow managed to get his right foot to it to clip it just wide of the post.
