Our first game of the Tour and everyone was fit and raring to go. The rain had hammered down for the journey to the grounds, but by the time the game started it had stopped and the sun was offering a weak heat, ideal playing conditions. Vios '38 were our first opposition, how would we do?

The line-up was:

We forced a corner early and it was met by Bryn at the back post who sent it back across for **Lore** who swung it in, over the 'keeper and in at the back post **0-1**. George had the ball wide on the left under pressure in our area, and then turned and went across field with the ball to Lore, who switched it inside for Callum's run, and he nicked it past the advancing 'keeper but was taken down in the process for a free-kick on the edge of the area. Callum took the free kick and curled it just over the back post. George found Bryn with a pass, and he in turn Callum, who shot, but the 'keeper parried and saved. Reece intercepted on the left and went down the line for Sam K to get the ball and he volleyed toward goal, but the 'keeper made the save. We had a throw which came back to Ben, so he crossed for the far post to where George headed it, but unfortunately off the head of a defender and out for a corner. A throw came to Lore, who saw the run of Max and flicked it off for him to go forward with the support of Aaron who laid it back to Max to win another corner. **Sam K** swung the corner in, and everyone ran in on the 'keeper, and in the confusion every player missed the ball, and it went in to the back post **0-2**. Reece under pressure lost his man and found George, who went past two players before being fouled on the edge of the area. It was swung in to the back post, came out to Callum and he shot, but it was over. We kept possession and kept up the pressure with Max winning the ball, finding Del, who exchanged passes with Lore

and was sent down the wing and crossed, and **Callum** headed it in **0-3**. A throw came to Aaron on the right, and he switched play to Reece on the left, and he lifted one into the area for Callum to head well wide.

HALF-TIME: VIOS 0 FRY 3

Del won it on the halfway line, played in Tom who turned and ran at goal before shooting, and it took the 'keeper two attempts to grab the ball. Del brought a high ball down, powered past two players and shot high. The 'keeper could only half save it and it dropped through his hands, however fortunately for Vios, only onto the line where he grabbed it at the second attempt. We had a free kick on the edge of the area, and George went to smash it with a long run, but disguised the ball to Tom, who lifted it past the 'keeper, and **Del** beat the defenders to the loose ball and blasted it into the roof of the net **0-4**. Noah ran down the line and crossed in, and Max nipped in to flick at goal, but just the wrong side of the post. Del hammered a corner right across the face of the goal, but no one got on the end of it. A lovely ball into Tom with his back to goal saw him turn and slip Max through and his shot hammered back off of the crossbar. Sam K then curled a corner in, Tom flicked on to **Max** facing the wrong way, but he swivelled and shot into the bottom corner **0-5**. Joel kept a ball from going out and found Del down the line and forced a corner which Tom swung in onto Bryn's chest under pressure, but his flick at goal was wide.
