Sam B hit a ball for Ben on his left foot in front of goal, but he tried to flick it with the outside of his right foot instead, and it went easily into the 'keeper's arms. Harry sent a ball for Callum to flick on for Lore, but as he cut onto his right, a defender got back and made the tackle. At this point Kvistgard made a substitution, and number **90** went off! They moved the ball down their right and quickly passed into the middle to where a shot flew in, but Harry took well, high in his chest, Kvistgard easily the hardest team we had faced. Callum took a quick throw to set Lore away; however his shot was so bad that it went out for a throw! A corner in was controlled by Ben by the penalty spot, but rather than try to turn he spotted Bryn on the edge, and he feinted a cross, and then went for the line and a cross, but their 'keeper dived out to punch away. Aaron strode out of defence for a tackle but caught the player for a free-kick, which luckily was blazed over.
