A great start to the game saw us passing the ball around a lot more, keeping possession better than we had in the first game. Lore picked the ball up wide on the left and shot after cutting in, but it rose over the far post. Boxey ran into the right corner, and then swept

the ball around 360 degrees with the outside of his foot, turning three players as he did, and then ran into the middle and crossed for Lore to hammer in from 10 yards 1-0. Del defending, beat a player and found Sam who advanced past a midfield player and his through ball found Boxey who was pushed very wide by their 'keeper, but still found the net from the narrow angle 2-0. Kai went down the right and crossed, and Sam tried to head for goal but didn't jump high enough, however Lore was behind him, and he controlled it on his chest and volleyed in 3-0. We gave away a freekick just outside the area which they smashed at goal. Harry dived brilliantly to parry, and then got up to jump on it as it dropped. Kai won the ball and broke out of defence, wide to Lore who was away with Kai inside him supporting, Lore went wide of the 'keeper and shot, but saw it blocked, however Kai had kept with him and finished it off 4-0. They won a free-kick 30 yards out which again they smashed at goal. A mix up between Aaron and Joel saw them away and chip for the far post, however Samuel had sprinted back and was there to cover as it ran wide. They won the ball in the middle and played it through for an attacker who looked offside, but was not flagged, and although Harry got a touch, the attacker passed it in **0-2**. A ball forward was headed on by Max

for Boxey and he was away, making sure of the goal as he went around the 'keeper 1-2. Bath were away down the left but Joel on the line blocked the goal, then Harry got a hand to it, and finally about five of our players jumped into the way and we were able to scramble it clear. Boxey crossed for Lore to shoot inches wide of the far post. A corner came in and Sam's header was cleared and they broke, but Joel held them up enough for Del to get there and slide in with a crunching tackle. Boxey cut past three players and shot, but it was blocked, and then he crossed for Lore to head at goal, but they had enough on the line to stop it. Another cross saw Lore jump and head goal-wards, off of the post, and it rebounded the wrong way as Max followed in. By this time both Lore and Lewis were off as tired legs after a long summer and tight muscles reduced us to 10 men for the last few minutes.
