Keynsham attacked down the left, played a guick onetwo and crossed to the middle where del tried to clear with his left, but it flew up instead, and from the scramble as it came down, Bryn won it, stepped to the right and unleashed a shot into the top right 1-0. Del attacked down the wing and crossed for Lewis to shoot with a half-turn volley, but unfortunately it was into the 'keeper's arms. They hit a ball into our left back area, so tom looked to hoof it up-field, but cleverly disquised it as he turned inside his man, before going inwards towards Lewis who played it on down the line for Boxey, who ran down the line and cut in, through five players before the last stopped him, however it came to Joe, who set it for Ben to wriggle through two players and shoot low into the bottom left 1-1. We worked a corner on the right through Boxey's hard work. Ben took a short one to Joe, and then ran after it for the return, which he chipped to the middle, and Sam rose unmarked in the middle to head in 1-2. They hammered a free-kick from the edge of the area, off of the cross-bar and we cleared it as it came down.

Keynsham then attacked again and crossed low, and Del, three yards out managed to turn it over the bar. They took a quick free-kick into the right corner where Tom faced two, and the cross in was hammered past Harry from close range **2-2**. Tom swung a corner in high to the back post; however Boxey's volley was from a very narrow angle, and the 'keeper was able to cover it. They hit a long ball over the top, however Harry was very alert and sprinted to the edge of his area to grab it just ahead of them. Tom and Joe combined well to break their attack, and played it through Del to Jay. Jay went down the line to Boxey, who ran all the way and cut in, but his shot flew across the face of the goal. Sean won the ball on the left, played it inside to Sam who shot low, but it was always going wide.

Boxey took on a defender down the right and crossed the ball in for Lore, but he was tackled as he shot.
