Our thanks and best wishes go to all the players and their parents and hope they have many fond memories of their time spent with Somerdale Wanderers/Fry Club Colts.

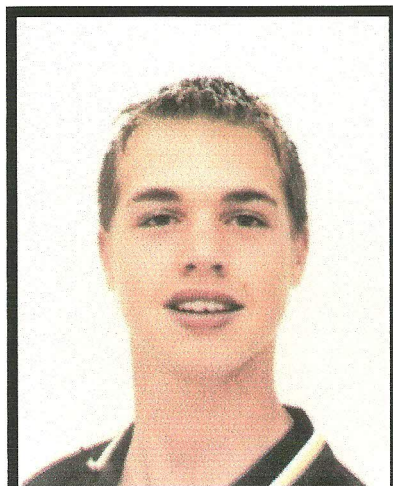
## DAVE GOODING TAKES OVER THE UNDER 14s
