

<u>Coaches, Team Managers And Club Officials – Respect</u> <u>Code Of Conduct</u>

We all bear a collective responsibility to set a good example and help provide a positive environment in which children can learn and enjoy the game. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct at all times. On and off the field, I will:

- **4** Use my position to set a positive example for the young people I am responsible for.
- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and Spectators.
- **4** Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game.
- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour.
- **4** Respect the match official's decision.
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat.
- ♣ Adhere to the Club's Anti-Bullying Policy.
- Never act in a manner which could be deemed by the Executive Committee to have brought myself, my Team, my Club or the FA into disrepute.

When working with players, I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning.
- Never engage in or tolerate any form of bullying.
- **4** Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Ensure all activities I organise are appropriate for the players' ability level, age and maturity.
- Co-operate fully with others in football (e.g. officials, doctors, physiotherapists, welfare officers) for each player's best interests.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA: I may be:

- **4** Required to meet with the club, league or County Welfare Officer.
- Suspended by the club from attending matches.
- Suspended or fined by the County FA.
- **4** Required to leave or be sacked by the club. In addition:
- ♣ My FA Coaching Licence may be withdrawn.
