We kicked off but they won the ball and attacked down our wing and all of our players chased them back, Aaron getting injured straight away and having to come off, and they scoring in the process **1-0**. From the kick off James got the ball. He ran at them, down the line past three players until he was ready to shoot, but was tackled at the last minute. From a loose ball in the middle we stood around, unsure of whom to go for it, so one of their players ran in and shot past Ethem 2-0. James ran all the way down the line, but his shot was into the side netting. They were then through and Ethem was getting the hang of this going in goal lark, and made a great save from the shot, and the loose ball was blasted over. The ball then came loose from a bit of a melee, and a quick shot found its way in 3-0. James attacked all the way down the wing and got the ball to Kruz in the middle and he hesitated and hesitated and we were all shouting shoot, so he finally went to

shoot, but was tackled at the last minute. attacked back as us and were through and Ethem came out and made a fantastic save for a corner, which was powered across and hit in 4-0. They threw the ball into our area, and our players stood and watched as it ran to a Brislington player and he hit it past Ethem. 14-1. They attacked again and a loose ball was shot against the post, Adam clearing it afterwards. They won the ball in our area and Ollie dived well to push it wide, Adam clearing afterwards. Brislington were reacting faster to loose balls just like in the first game, and a well struck shot was matched by Ollie's save. We attacked through Bradley, but he was crowded out as he advanced into their area. They attacked into our area and passed it past Ollie 2-0. They won it back from the kick and attacked down their right, and Ollie tried to kick the shot clear but he missed it **3-0**. We kicked off, one of their players won it and just leathered it high into the top corner giving Ollie no chance 4-0. A massive kick from their 'keeper ran all the way through to a Brislington attacker who swung a boot at it but it came back off of the post. Ollie's drop kick was won by a Brislington player as no one from our team went for it and he shot straight away as Ollie was running back, so Ollie didn't see it until too late **5-0**. They attacked through again, but Ollie
