Lukas slid in very well to win his tackle, but we weren't able to do much as we were hemmed in. Then their big attacker sprung forward, and this time no one made the tackle and he played it past Ethem **0-1**. From a throw, we attacked forward and Bradley shot, but it was always going wide. James ran at them to win the ball, and then Lukas ran at goal but was crowded, so Aran took it up and was just denied a shot by a James battled for the ball out last tackle. wide, working through two players before shooting from distance 1-1. From kick off we passed it backwards and a switched on player ran in to win it and blast it past Ollie **0-1**. From the kick off we did it again with the same result **0-2**. We were far less switched on for this game, and in a direct opposite we were not! Their players were running at us at will and another shot flew in **0-**3. Then they won it on the halfway line, ran at us with no challenge and buried it **0-4**. They had a throw and the attacker ran towards goal with Ollie out of position and made it 0-5. A Chew Valley attacker won the ball and shot at goal through the crowd, and Ollie was in line to make the save, but it hit Aaron and deflected past him **0-6**. Liam made a great effort to win the ball and attack into their area, but his shot flew just wide. Chew Valley attacked again and Liam made what turned out to be his second bad foul prompting Chew officials to question his motives, however I stuck up for him and said that he wasn't that sort of player.....
