From the start we were on the back foot as this Boco team were evidently a strong team, with passing and awareness in their starting four. The early exchanges saw lots of shots flying in at our goal, one off of the post and quite a few saved by Ethem, however we did concede, firstly as Aran tried to dribble the ball from in front of our goal and was caught just about two yards from Ethem and they shot past him 0-1. Then we were shouting to Lukas to take a throw forward, but instead he threw across our goal and they intercepted and scored **0-2**. Ethem kicked to Aran, and he played it across to Lukas, who then passed forward Bradley who attacked into their half. Although he was stopped, it was a nice passage of play. We then kicked forward and Kaylum was after it but was tackled. Unfortunately everyone else had run with him and so the way to Ethem's goal was clear **0-3**. We threw it forwards to James, but he was tackled by their large player who ran into a half which was again

From a throw, Ethem got it and ran the whole pitch, but shot just wide. They had a free-kick and Charlie charged it down but his shot was too close to the 'keeper. Then we were defending and Cory broke away, but shot too early and the 'keeper saved. Ethem was fouled on the halfway line and took it quickly to Cory who had stayed up and he fired it through the 'keeper's legs 1-0. We had the ball on the edge of our area, and then passed backwards without looking and fortunately it hit our post and came out! pressured them and forced his way towards goal with the ball, before finding Liam with it and he shot from a narrow angle but just the wrong side of the post.
