This was the last match of our first season of matches. We were at Home and only Kruz was unavailable.

The Game 1 line-up was:

James threw the ball down the line for Tyler, and he lifted it into the area towards Ollie, but he was unable to make meaningful contact. Keanu rolled out to James, and he spotted Kaylum in the clear, finding him with his pass, but the final shot was straight at the 'keeper. Keanu rolled out to Adam on the left, and he passed across the pitch to James, and after attacking down the line he shot, but the 'keeper managed to hold on to it with Kaylum following in for any rebound. threw to James and he passed it inwards for Adam, who found Kaylum with a threaded pass through the middle, but he was tackled as he went to shoot. James intercepted their attack and countered, only to see his shot pushed around the post by their 'keeper. A poor pass out was caught by Kaylum who shot, it hit the 'keeper and bounced on towards goal, however the defender on the line cleared it. A ball played into Aran saw him turn past the defender and shoot, but again the 'keeper saved. Tyler cleared their attack and Aran was after it, jinking left and right with the defender turning his back and then unleashed a shot that flew low past the 'keeper 1-0. We were defending but Aran stole it off of their defender and was away, before running in at an angle

towards goal, and blasting it high through the 'keeper's hands and into the back of the net **2-0**. From the kick their attacker ran straight at us, shooting through the crowd which meant that Keanu saw it late and it was in **2-1**. Keanu rolled it to Tristen who in turn found Bradley up the pitch. He passed it inside to Aran whose forward ball found Tyler, and he crossed for Bradley, just as the whistle blew.

Ashton started with a cross field ball from right to left which saw the attacker swing his leg at it, and the ball cannon back and out off of the crossbar with Bradley rooted to the spot. Bradley threw to Liam, and he played a great ball through their heart for Cory to latch on to, but their 'keeper managed a save. Charlie in defence spotted Aaron away, and his ball down the line resulted in Aaron shooting wide. Charlie then received the ball midway in their half and elected to shoot, but it went narrowly wide. Cory chased a ball towards their big defender and just bounced off of him! That defender than powered a shot, but Bradley was in line with it. The ball appeared to be going out on the right but Aaron chased and kept it in, finding Cory down the line and he crossed in towards Liam and the ball was soon nestling in the bottom corner 1-0. From the kick they shot early, Liam swung a leg and missed, but the movement distracted Bradley and it dropped through his legs and in 1-1. A corner was swung in, Bradley came for the punch but missed and it hit the knee of an Ashton player and bounced in **1-2**. Cory played the ball down the line for **Finn** to chase, and through sheer determination he fought through two defenders to shoot, beating the 'keeper at the near post, and the resulting look of shock on his face was priceless 2-2.
