Liam was played through by Charlie, and with the 'keeper to beat and defenders bearing down on him, he powered a shot hard and high past the Almost from the kick-off, despairing dive **1-1**. Warmley ran at us and the defensive idea seemed to evaporate as they charged through us, leaving Alfie no chance **2-1**.
