We were taking good corners but were unable to get the final touch, and from a good corner from Charlie the ball came back to Ethem who passed to Liam whose shot was welled saved by the 'keeper. The defender and 'keeper both went for the same ball and the ball came back to Liam whose shot went just wide. From the goal-kick Charlie got to the ball first and passed to Brad who was about to shoot when he was fouled. Brad took the free-kick which was well saved by the 'keeper however the ball came back to **Brad** who beat the defender before shooting past the 'keeper 2-0. We had another corner which went all the way through to Liam, who did some skills and tried to get a shot away but it was blocked, and the ball came back to Keanu who shot just wide.

Bradley Stoke played some good football down the right hand side, we tried but could not get a tackle in and they played the ball into the middle and they shot past Cory to score 2-1. Bradley Stoke got some confidence from the goal and attacked again and only a good block from Ethem avoided another goal, although at the expense of conceding a corner. From the corner Bradley got to the ball first, passed to Charlie who hit a wonderful pass to **Liam** who calmly waited for the 'keeper to make his move before finishing well 3-1. Bradley Stoke came at us and got to the edge of the area, Ethem tried to tackle the player but conceded a free-kick. They hit the free-kick well and Cory made a good save but they were quicker to react and tapped it past Cory 3-2.

We started on the front foot to begin the 1st half with James going on a run past a defender and towards the corner flag where he got over a good looking cross which was just behind where Bartek was standing, however Bartek managed to get to the ball and turn to get his shot away which drifted just wide of the far post. As in the first game, Bradley Stoke were passing the ball well but the boys were working hard to close them down and getting in some good tackles to prevent them getting any chances. defending in our half when Finn got in a crucial tackle and played the ball to Brad who broke quickly and played the ball inside to James who beat one defender and then got a shot away which the 'keeper saved well. From the kick Kaylum closed their player down and got a block in which deflected to Bartek who laid the ball off well to Bradley who shot narrowly wide.
