There was guite a big slope on the pitch and we were shooting up it in the first half. Boco started the game very well and were soon passing the ball around. We were defending very well and a well-timed tackle from Liam prevented them from getting a telling cross into the box. Liam passed the ball wide to Brad W who beat one player before getting tackled as he was about to pass. They broke very quickly down their right before getting a cross in and Finn did well to clear the ball. They were quicker to the loose ball though and hit a low shot which was heading to the bottom corner only for Alfie to get down quickly and tip the ball around the post for a corner. From the corner Ethem did well to get to the ball first and looked to clear it to Bartek who got to the ball and laid it off to Charlie who passed out wide to Finn who though did his best, was unable to get to the ball before it went out for a throw, but this was a good effort at turning defence in to attack. Boco were still moving the ball well and were attacking down the right and whipped in a good cross. Finn had done well to track back and looked to knock the ball behind for a corner but was very unfortunate to see the ball bobble into the bottom corner 1-0. From a goal-kick Cory got the ball from Alfie, drew the attacker in before passing to Charlie who took the ball on a couple of yard before hitting a 30-yard pass cross field to Bartek; this was not just a boot up-field, it a measured pass that any player at any level would have been proud of. Bartek ran onto the ball with only the goalie to beat and looked for the far post but dragged it wide of the post. Boco were attacking down their right again but some good team work from Liam and Brad G forced them out wide and we were unlucky to concede the corner. Boco took a good corner into our box and Brad W did well to get to the ball first and clear it; they picked it up on the edge of the area, Liam went to close him down but they shifted the ball quickly to a player on the edge of the area who unleased a cracking shot that came off of the post and in, giving Alfie no chance **2-0**. We had a corner which Charlie took short to Brad G who took the ball closer to the penalty box, passed the ball back to Charlie who now had a good angle to shoot, which he hit, a good high hard shot which the 'keeper did well to save.

Finn got the ball in our half and cut the ball inside to Brad G who passed to Brad W, who played the ball to Bartek who got the ball under control before firing in a really sharp cross. Brad G had done well to get into the box and was unfortunate that the ball was at an awkward height and he could only get a knee to the ball which flew over the bar. They took a big goal kick which Brad G headed to Brad W, and he picked up the loose ball and found Charlie who thread the ball through to Bartek who pushed it on to Liam who did very well to cut inside and with no other option available cracked a shot off towards the Boco goal which their 'keeper did well to get down to. As in the first game we started playing up the slope, however we were more switched on than in the first game and Aran was soon clear with a run-on goal; he had Finn in the box ready for a tap in but decided to go for a shot himself that went wide. Tristen picked the ball up on the wide right and passed inside to Aran who was proving to be a real handful for the Boco team and they were unable to get a tackle in as Aran jinked left then right and gave himself a yard of space before crossing the ball that just went over Finn's head; if he was one inch taller it could have gone in, but it drifted out for a goal-kick. Boco, as in the first game were looking to pass the ball and they had one skilful player who was using all of his tricks and beat Jamie to get a powerful shot away which Alfie saved well. The game was a good battle between two very good teams that were cancelling each other out and the chances were few and far between. Tyler was determined to get to a loose ball first and beat the Boco player to the ball just inside our half; he knocked the ball inside to James who went wide before cutting inside and shooting, the ball skimmed across the surface which the 'keeper did well to get down to and make a good save. They now attacked us and they managed to get the ball out wide on the left-hand side to their star player who controlled the ball well and worked space for himself before hitting the ball under Alfie and into the empty net 1-0.
