Hanham started the game really well and they were passing the ball around in midfield and a pass through the middle saw their quick striker in the clear; Alfie came out to narrow the angle, the striker aimed for the far corner, but the ball just went wide. Alfie played the ball to Tristen who took his time and waited for the Hanham player to come to him before passing down the line where he found James who used his skill and pace to get past a Hanham player before passing the ball to Bartek who got to the edge of the penalty area before shooting with the ball drifting just wide. The Hanham 'keeper played a simple pass to the defender who looked to clear up field but Aran had read the situation well and intercepted the ball; his first touch was pure class and he then ran guick and direct at the Hanham defence who could not get a tackle in and in a blink of an eye he was in the area, before with power and accuracy Aran hit the ball behind the 'keeper into the back of the net 1-0. We were playing some good football and Tristen combined well with Bradley who had space in front of him to run into which he did at great pace; the defender came across to
