We started slowly and Warmley were soon on the attack, and only a last-ditch tackle from Keanu prevented a chance, the ball going behind for a corner. They floated the ball into the middle, and they reacted quicker than we did and a free shot near the penalty box was not going to be missed, the ball flew in 1-0. Warmley were playing well and moving the ball with ease and were a yard guicker than we were! A great move saw them power a shot towards the net, but Alfie made a great save at his near post. We tried to pass the ball out and a ball from Tristen came to Bartek in the middle of our half; he beat one man well but was tackled when looking to release the ball, they reacted well and it was suddenly three of them against Tristen who did his best but a nice pass through left Alfie exposed as two players bore down on goal and they finished well to give a deserved two goal lead 2-0. We started to

play some football and a lovely exchange of passes between James and Tyler saw Tyler shoot from outside the area; the Warmley player blocked it but with his hands giving us a free kick just outside of the area. James took the free kick, but the shot just went over the bar. Warmley broke quickly but Cory had come back and intercepted the cross to knock the ball behind for a corner. The corner was cleared by Keanu, but they got to the ball first and fired the ball across the goal that they managed to deflect in James made a great tackle to prevent a Warmley attack and he passed up the middle to Tyler who passed first time out wide where Bartek had gotten into space; he ran to the edge of the area before firing a shot towards goal which the 'keeper did well to get to but was unable to stop the ball going in 3-1.

We were soon on the front foot and a lovely pass from Charlie sent Kaylum away and he sprinted down the wing before cutting the ball back to Liam who hit a rocket of a shot which just flew just wide of the post. Warmley cleared the ball long into our half where Finlay got to the ball first and played into the middle where **James** has some space to run into and he glided past one player before unleashing a shot which gave the 'keeper no chance 0-1. We were dominating the game and a good pass from Cory found Charlie just inside our half; he played it out wide to Kaylum who in-turn fed it back to Charlie and he drilled a shot against the bar; a great move and strike which deserved more. It was one way traffic and a skilful run from Bradley had the Warmley defence chasing shadows. He then cut the ball back to Liam whose shot was well saved by the 'keeper. Warmley attacked down the middle and a good block from Finlay pushed them wide, however they still managed to cut a ball into the area and Alfie was very brave and dived on the ball before they could get a clear shot away. Alfie saw Charlie in space and played the ball out wide, and he chipped a ball perfectly to Liam who was away and got himself into a position to score, but just as he was about to pull the trigger the goalkeeper came out and nicked the ball of a Liam's toes. They went long again but Kaylum took the ball down with great control and skill before passing to Bradley who drifted to the edge of the area before shooting, the ball coming off the post and wide.
