Imperial were first to attack and were used to playing on the superb 4G surface and had quickly moved the ball to the edge of our area where a great tackle from Liam prevented them from getting a shot Liam calmly played the ball to Cory who awav. tricked his way past one player before passing inside to James who with great energy powered into the Imperial half before shooting just wide. They played some good football down their right and a cross into the box had us in trouble, and a good block from Finley could only see the ball come to one of their players on the edge of the area who made no mistake in firing the ball past Alfie 1-0. They were soon attacking down their left and again put in a good cross; we had done well in tracking back and were extremely unlucky, as in making a great effort in getting back Bartek managed to get the important touch to give Alfie no chance 2-0. Andy made a tactical switch putting Cory into defence making us a solid three in defence, three in midfield with Bradley W dropping onto the left side of Midfield. The new formation had an effect straight away with Cory passing down the line to Bradley who with great silky

skills tricked his past a defender before crossing to where Bartek had made up a lot of ground; he had to stretch to get to the ball and could only direct wide for a goal-kick, but a great move. It was a battle in midfield with neither side able to create much. On more than one occasion James, who was working hard broke up play and was getting about the pitch well. Finley made a crucial tackle and found Liam who looked up and played a cracker of a ball to Bartek and managed to get a touch on it and move it away from the defender; he took a shot from distance that the 'keeper clung on to. The 'keeper then kicked long up-field, we let the ball bounce and it came straight to the striker who hit a rocket of a shot that somehow Alfie reached and pushed around post a save of great ability.

Not for the first time this season we started slowly, and Imperial were soon on the attack. The ball came into the penalty box and Ethem did well to get to the ball first; by the time he had controlled the ball and looked to clear it though, an Imperial player was closing him down and blocked the clearance, and he then shot past the diving Cory 1-0. Imperial were playing some good football and we were struggling to get out of our half. A great tackle from Tristen prevented a clear shot on goal with his clearance going out for a corner. The corner was swung in, the ball coming off Ethem, but we did not react, and the ball was fired in through a body of players and nestled into the corner of the net 2-0. Keanu intercepted the ball and passed out wide to Charlie who saw Bradley in the middle and played a ball into him; Bradley waited for Charlie to continue his run before passing back. Charlie ran on and shot, the 'keeper doing well to save. They managed to get the ball into our half and shoot from distance; Cory watched the bounce before making a good save. Cory passed the ball out wide to Kaylum who ran to the halfway line before passing into Bradley and he passed first time back to Kaylum who ran with the ball to edge of the area and then cut the ball back to Bradley who took a touch before firing a shot from the edge of the area that flew into the bottom corner of the net **2-1**.
