We had not played Stoke Lane in a match before but had some good games in tournaments against them; the rain held off for the match and the pitch was in good condition for the first home game of the season. The game started at a frantic pace with Stoke Lane first to venture into our half, but a well-timed tackle prevented the attack coming to anything. Cory then played the ball down the line to Bradley who powered forward before passing to Finlay and passed back to Bradley who was now at the edge of the area; he crossed the ball to Bartek who with his first touch gave himself a yard of space before shooting; the 'keeper did well to make the save but he could not hold onto it and **Kaylum** was on hand to fire the ball home 1-0. Keanu had the ball in our half and as we have told the boys, played the ball the way he was facing and passed the ball back to Ethem who picked the ball up; one of the new rules this year is that if the ball is passed back and the 'keeper picks it up then an indirect free kick is given. The boys got back on the line, but the free kick deflected off of a couple of bodies and rolled into the net 1-1. Liam did well to win the ball in our half and then fed a glorious ball down the right to Finlay who sprinted down the wing and got to the corner of the box

before firing a low cross/shot into the area; the ball zipped off of the surface and gave the 'keeper no chance as the ball snuck in at the near post 2-1. We were looking to break and a good-looking ball from Keanu was just intercepted when it looked like Bartek would be away; we had gone forward in numbers so when they intercepted the ball, they were able to run up the middle unopposed and ran into the area and simply passed the ball passed Ethem into the net 2-2. We were playing some great football and the passing was of the highest order and a great passing move involving Bradley, Kaylum and Liam eventually saw Bradley pinpoint his cross to Bartek whose shot would have gone in if not for a last-ditch block on the ball to divert it out for a corner. Liam took a great corner which Kaylum got to first, his shot well saved. There was then a battle in midfield which Stoke Lane won with the deflected ball falling nicely to their player who had stayed forward; he waited for Ethem to make his move before shooting low and hard past him 2-3. We were still the better side and a great pass from Cory to Bradley sent us on our way, and again Bradley cut the ball inside to Bartek who laid it off to Liam who hit a bullet of a shot which deflected off the defender's head into the back of the net 3-3. Stoke Lane were struggling to make any headway into our half, but they did get through once, however Ethem stayed big and strong and made a good save. We were moving the ball well and a nice ball from Keanu found Finlay and he played it inside to Liam who looked up and saw Cory in space and played the ball to him; Cory shot first time across goal, the ball only going inches wide. We were playing with great confidence now and a fantastic ball from Kaylum found Bartek out wide; he skilfully beat two players before floating over a delightful cross into the box; it looked like it was going to drift wide, but Liam sprung into the air and put a lovely diving header into the back of the net 6-3. There was no more time for either side to attack again before the ref blew the full-time whistle.

We started well and a glorious ball from Charlie found James out wide; he cut in and beat two players before shooting just wide. Tristen collected the ball in our half and played the ball out wide to Tyler who cleverly went past a player before playing the ball into the middle where **Bradley** had got into space; he took the ball under his spell before calmly finishing past the diving 'keeper 1-0. We were playing some lovely stuff and James was controlling the play well, not only with some good football but leading the team with a Captain's performance. A good pass from James found Bradley out wide and he got to the ball and crossed into the middle where Charlie laid it back to James who hit a shot which rattled the bar and went over. A nice move started by Charlie found Aran who used his power to beat two players before passing out wide to Tyler and he crossed to Aran whose shot was blocked for a corner. James took a great corner which Charlie managed to get to and got a shot away which was well saved by the 'keeper.
