The game started at a frantic pace with Mangotsfield attacking down the right; Ethem came to the player and made a great tackle that prevented a shot coming in, the ball went loose and Bradley W was first to it where he played the ball into the middle to Tyler who flicked the ball past a player before moving the ball on to James who tricked his way past a player before shooting from distance; the 'keeper doing well to get down and make a save. Kaylum got to the goal-kick and passed in-field to Tyler who glided into the penalty box before shooting just wide The football from both sides was of the post. excellent and it was a good game of football between two evenly matched sides. A quick break from Mangotsfield saw them get to the edge of our area and they looked to whip in a cross, but Finley was there and blocked it behind for a corner. The corner swung in, and they got to the ball first and poked it towards goal; Alfie doing well to dive on it and make a vital save. We were moving the ball well and a crackerjack of a pass from Bradley set James away; he ran into space and had the intelligence to wait for

the defender to come to him before passing the ball on to Tyler who fizzed a shot towards goal that he was unlucky to see just fly by the wrong side of the goal. Mangotsfield were playing some good football and passing the ball well. They worked the ball down the left side and got a cross in, the ball took a couple of deflections and ended up at feet of one of their players a couple of yards out from goal and he had the easy job of tapping the ball in **0-1**. A good run from James down the right created space for Kaylum to run into, and James found Kaylum with a lovely Kaylum looked up and shot, the ball hit a defender and came back to Bradley who shot first time and it went high looking like it was going into the top corner, but it rose just a little too much and went off the top of the crossbar and over.

Mangotsfield then attacked quickly, Finley did well to slow them down and make a terrific tackle, but the ball went to another of the Mangotsfield players who fired from distance; Alfie sprung into the air and got the slightest of touches on the ball to deflect it on to the bar, and Ethem was quickest to react and clear the danger. After a battle in midfield, it ended with Bradley coming away with the ball and going for a run down the left before passing inside to James; two defenders came to him, and once Tyler was in space James slid the perfect ball to him. **Tyler** was clear on goal, so he looked up, picked his spot and drilled the ball past the 'keeper into the net **1-1**. A good ball from Finley found Kaylum who got the ball out from under his feet to bamboozle two defenders before looking up and seeing Bradley in space at the edge of area. The ball came across to Bradley who took a touch before shooting hard and

low, the 'keeper just getting down in time to make a smart save. A quick break from them and they were in our half in a flash with a quick exchange of passes and then it was at the edge of the area and then a shot came in that Alfie watched all the way and caught the ball. Ethem cleared the ball up-field to Tyler who controlled the ball well and laid it off to James who fired just over as the ref blew the full-time whistle to end a thoroughly entertaining game of football.

We were on the front foot very quickly and a good pass from Bradley found Liam who did well to work the ball out wide left for Charlie who took a touch to take the defender out of the game before unleashing a rocket of a shot that gave the 'keeper no chance 1-**0**. Another good move saw Cory finding Charlie, and he pushed it on to Bartek who shot just wide. We were totally dominating, with Mangotsfield not able to deal with our passing, and a great ball from Charlie found Bradley who wriggled his way past two players, drawing the 'keeper to him, before he crossed it to Bartek to knock the ball in the back of the net 2-0. It was all one way to begin with and our passing was top notch; a quick passing move with Bradley and Charlie opened them up, Bradley then passed to Bartek who shot with power giving the 'keeper no chance **3-0**. When the Mangotsfield goalkeeper got the ball he always went long and on most times we dealt with it, however on one occasion they got through and looked like they were one on one, but out of nowhere Cory got back and made the vital tackle and got the ball to Keanu who passed it to Charlie, and he battled really well to beat three players before playing a pin-point cross to Liam whose crisply hit shot was well saved by the 'keeper. The 'keeper went long again, and they raced in behind us and the player calmly slid the ball past Kaylum into the corner 3-1. They cleared the ball long, but Cory got to it first and played the ball to Bartek and he played a great ball to Bradley who skipped between two defenders and then waited for the 'keeper to make his move before putting the ball past the 'keeper into the net 4-1. They played the ball through the middle and had a shot from distance; Kaylum did really to get to it but was unable to keep it out 4-2.

We were working hard down the centre and left and quick couple of passes between Bradley and Charlie meant that Bradley out wide crossed it into Charlie who thumped the ball into the net 9-2. A good throw from Cory found Bartek who did well to get a great cross into Charlie and he placed the ball past the 'keeper 10-2. From their goal kick the ball went to Bradley who took a touch before passing to Charlie who in a flash saw the 'keeper out of position and finished past him 11-2. Mangotsfield kept going and never gave up but Keanu and Cory at the back were determined with their defending and did not let them get close to Kaylum's goal in the 2nd half.
