We were shooting uphill in the first half. They started well and were passing the ball around and a ball came through the middle, and they shot hard and low, Alfie making a good save. We looked to play the ball out from the back and a good ball from Tristen found Josh and he looked to play the ball forward and they knocked it out for a throw. Kaylum took the throw and found Bradley and he went past the defender before shooting across the 'keeper, but the ball drifted just wide. They went long and a flick on from one of their defenders beat our offside trap and they were clean on goal and slotted the ball past Alfie **0-1**. They had most of the possession, but we were defending well and a good tackle from Josh set us on a rare attack and a great ball from Josh found Bradley. With no one out wide he had to go forward on his own and he beat a defender before shooting, the 'keeper making a good save, then they broke down their right side but Cory had kept track of the winger and when he went to cut inside Cory made a great tackle getting the ball off of him and passing down the wing to Finley who passed inside to Bradley who burst forward with great pace and threaded a ball through to Josh who hit a cross/shot that just drifted past the far post. They were passing the ball well in the
