We started well and a good pass from Liam found James who shot from just outside the box, but the ball was well saved by the 'keeper. Some good play down the right by James found Bradley G who crossed the ball to Bartek, but he headed the ball just wide. We were putting them under pressure and the ball was hit into the box by Cory where there was a scramble and we got three different efforts toward the goal but somehow the ball would not go in, then they broke into our half, but Keanu was quickly out and made a good save. We were trying to play good passing football in awful conditions and a good pass out of defence from Tristen found Josh out wide and he went past a player before crossing; Bartek got a shot away, but it was narrowly wide. A good pass from Bradley G found Bradley W who shot from distance; it beat the 'keeper but just drifted wide. A lovely ball from Bradley W was played down the line to Bradley G who whipped it across to James whose shot flicked up in the air, Bradley G had followed in and got a head to it which was cleared off the line and it came back to Bartek who flicked it towards goal but the 'keeper made the save. From their goal-kick it came to Bradley G who passed wide to Bradley W who hit a lovely, lobbed shot over the 'keeper into the back of the net **0-1**. A good run from Finley forced his way into their half; he then passed to Josh whose shot was well saved by the 'keeper. They finished as they had begun with a lot of possession, but our defence was solid and stopped them getting any chances.

We were playing well and pinning them in their half and the ball was cleared but it only came to Cory whose shot was tipped onto the cross bar and then dropped on to the post; very unlucky to not double our lead. They then had us pinned in and a good cross came in, but Liam did well to knock it out for a corner. They got a good shot in that Keanu save well but they reacted first to the rebound to score 1-1. We broke quickly from their next corner and a good ball from Finley found Liam who knocked it up to Bartek who passed to Bradley W who toe-poked it just wide. Good defending from Josh saw him get to the ball first before laying it up to Bartek who set Bradley G away, but he got bogged down in the mud and they tackled him and broke and managed to get a good shot that Keanu did well to save.
