We were in our away red kit for the first game and we started well and were passing the ball around and put them under pressure causing them to handle the ball. James took the free-kick and it floated over the bar. We were just caught off side and they took a quick free-kick that caught us out and they hit a stinging shot that hit the bar and Alfie dived on it. From their goal-kick we got the ball off of them Bartek put a ball through, but it was just out of Bradley G's reach, but he got a toe poke that the 'keeper saved and put behind for a corner. They were soon on the attack and a good block form Cory prevented the cross coming in and went behind for a corner. The game then settled into a strong midfield battle without much being created. A ball was played down their left side, Finn got to it and went to look to see it out; the ball crossed a line but unfortunately not the right line and they nipped in and played the ball into the box; James did well and got back to make a tackle, the ball went behind for a corner, the ref though saw the Bradley Stoke player had gone down under the challenge and gave a penalty, their player hit a great penalty, Alfie got a hand to it but was unable to keep it out 1-0. They kept us pinned in for a bit, but we were defending well and some good defending from Josh stopped them in their tracks. From a free kick Cory found James who beat one man before shooting just wide.

We were a bit shell shocked at the goal not being allowed and the pinned us back, Josh got a tackle in that the ref gave as a free-kick at the edge of the area they hit a great free-kick that went into the top corner not giving Alfie a chance 2-0. This to be fair was a blow to the boys but they kept going and this was shown when Bradley Stoke worked the ball into the area; a good save from Alfie came back to them, Cory then got a block in it came back to them again who shot this time Finn blocked it then Bradley W blocked it before finally Tristen blocked it and made a great clearance.
