From the resulting goal kick Cory won the ball and passed inside to **Bradley** who shot from 25 yards; he did not connect cleanly but it did go high and the 'keeper had the sun in eyes and it went past him and into the net 1-0. We were not playing as well as we could but still dominating and from a ball by Josh which found Tyler he ran through the Keynsham defensive line before hitting a great shot that came thundering off the bar and Bradley was in place to knock it past the 'keeper 2-0. We were in total control and closing down from their goal kick James won the ball before passing to Bradley who crossed for Tyler whose shot was saved by the 'keeper. From a goal kick James won the ball again went down the wing before crossing to the far post where Oakley was to finish off the move for his first goal for the club 3-0.
